

Introduction: reading of the scripture from all four books in an orderly fashion. (Because of the volume of verses used, and, I did not seek permission to print, I cannot run off a copy for all of you.)

THE HISTORY OF THE STORY

1. It starts in earnest with the resurrection of Lazarus in Bethany, about four to five months before the crucifixion of Christ, John 11:1-44
2. The Chief Priest and other leaders plot to kill Jesus, so He leaves for the area of Samaria and Galilee, John 11:45-54; Luke 17:11
3. He heals the ten lepers, Luke 17:12-19
4. At some point He heads south again to the region of Perea. Jesus blesses the children and speaks to the rich young ruler. Matt. 19:1-12; Mk 10:13-31; Lk 18:15-30
5. He journeys to Jericho where He heals Blind Bartimaeus, Mk. 10:46-52; Lk 18:35-43.
6. He speaks to Zacchaeus and gives the parable of the Minas, Lk 19:1-27
7. He returns to the home of Mary and Martha in Bethany where the Chief Priest and other leaders plot to kill him, John 11:55-12:11. This was probably early spring. The leaves were out on the trees. Matthew 24:32.
8. The day of the Triumphal Entry started in Bethany to Jerusalem and later that evening returned to Bethany, Matt 21:1-9; Mk 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; John 12:12-19 in March or April of 30 A.D.

THE HISTORY OF THAT DAY

1. Getting the donkey fulfilled prophetic scripture of their king coming on a donkey. We are fulfilling scripture as well when we do what Jesus tells us to do via the Holy Spirit. The church around the world are together fulfilling scripture.
2. This is our day and our time of visitation Luke 19:42 & v. 44. The fig tree tells us it is our day. It is a time to watch and be about our Father's business Matthew 24:32-35 & Luke 21:32-35
3. Who do you say He is? A Prophet, a social worker, King of Israel, Messiah?

THE PRAISE OF MULTITUDES, John 12:12-13 Mark 11:9-10

1. Multitudes from both directions, Bethany and Jerusalem. Also, Matt21:9
2. Let's worship Him and maybe use Psalm 145.
